1. Survey ~ A way of gathering data that involves asking people for information.
2. Qualitative Data ~ Data in the form of words, drawings, or other non-numeric forms that describes the characteristics of something.
3. Quantitative Data ~ Numerical data based on measurements that describes amounts.
4. Study ~ A careful observation and description of an event, object, or organism; studies do not change conditions or behaviors but simply describe things.
5. Experiment ~ A controlled procedure carried out to discover, test, or demonstrate something.
6. Variable ~ Something in an experiment that can be changed.
