Title Slide (15 points)

- Title (5 points)
- Name (5 points)
- Link your title to your article. (5 points)

5-8 Informational Slides (35 points)

- All information is summarized into your own words. (-20 if copied)
- Focus is on how your topic relates to one or more physical science topics. (15 points)
- Includes at least one list (bulleted or numbered with 4 or more items) or one table (at least 3 x 3). (5 points)
- Each slide has a different transition. (5 points)
- At least one item on each slide is animated (enters, exits, or emphasizes). (5 points)
- Includes at least 3 relevant pictures. (5 points)

General (20 points)

- Information is organized in an interesting and logical way. (10 points)
- Visually appealing and easily readable. (10 points)
- Correct grammar, capitalization, punctuation and spelling. (-5 if multiple errors)
- Relevant. (-5 for each off-topic item)

Presentation (30 points)

- Done on time. (-10 if late)
- Speak at an appropriate level. (5 points)
- Speak at an appropriate speed. (5 points)
- Address the audience. (5 points)
- Present all material on slides. (5 points)
- Know your material. (5 points)
- Be serious. (5 points)
